Cars must be adequately muffled.

Competitors must be able to produce a valid and current:

- Motorsport Australia Competition Licence
- Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Car Club
- Log Book (if issued) at document check.

## **CLASSES:**

Classes as per 2020 NSW Motorkhana Series Regulations.

Prizes and/or trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Outright.

Other prizes and/or trophies may be awarded at the organisers discretion.

## **COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS:**

**Due to Covid-19 requirements this event will not be open to spectators. Entries will only be accepted via the online entry portal or email prior to the event. No on-the-day entries accepted.**

Please do not attend if you are unwell or in isolation.

All attendees will be required to supply their name and contact details to be kept in a register.

Social distancing rules must be followed. Please only occupy every second paddock bay so that a safe distance can be maintained between attendees. Please do not crowd around in the covered areas.

Drivers briefing notes and test maps will be sent out by email, with any last minute information to be given out over the PA system.

Entry to the secretaries office will be by invitation only.

Hand washing facilities will be provided, along with hand sanitiser.

Entrants and their crew will need to provide their own masks/gloves if they wish to use them.

Entrants are permitted a maximum of one other person to attend as a passenger/pit crew/support personnel.

Please bring your own pen to sign any documents if required.

Entrants, Crew, etc are to minimise any contact with other people that may be at the venue for another event on the day.

## **OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS:**

Maximum of 40 entries. Maximum of 2 entrants per vehicle. Where multiple entrants are driving the same vehicle they must be from the same family/household.

Entry Fees – ADULTS = \$30; JUNIOR (other Motorsport Australia affiliated club) = \$15  
MGCCN JUNIOR = \$Free

This event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.

Junior entrants under the age of 18 may have a passenger as an instructor, but only if that passenger is from the same household. No other passengers will be permitted.

Entrants will be required to complete and return a Scrutiny Declaration form.

Officials will be carrying out scrutineering 'spot checks' as required to ensure safety and compliance.

Test patterns will be emailed to competitors prior to the event.

Penalties will be applied as per the National Motorkhana Code

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.

Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/ guardian.

Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

### **ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
