The Rocker Cover Racing is very popular at the Clubnights and a special set of rules have been drawn up. The NATMEET rules which are specific to National Meetings are on the website.

ROCKER COVER RACER RULES For MGCC Newcastle Club Nights

The Racers

The racers cannot have any power source. Gravity only!

The rocker/valve cover must not exceed 600mm in length.

The racer shall not be more than 40 mm longer than the rocker/valve cover.

Racers shall have four wheels of not more than 155 mm diameter.

Wheel track shall be not more than 200 mm.

Maximum weight shall not exceed 3 kg.

The Course

The decline will be 1.5 metres long followed by a level run of 6 metres.

The decline shall be divided into 2 lanes each 450 mm wide. The decline shall be 600 mm high at the starting line. The front of the decline will be bevelled to give a smooth transition to the run-out area.

A mechanical starting gate may be employed.

The run-out section shall be of 2 lanes 900 mm wide. The lanes shall be clearly marked.

The finish line shall be marked 6 metres from the front edge of the launch decline.

The Race

One entry per racer.

Each heat will consist of 2 racers

The first round of heats shall be the best of 3 runs on alternate lanes. Following heats shall be sudden death knockout.

The racers will start with the front of the racer against the starting pin.

The first racer to cross the finish line within its lane is the winner. If neither racer makes it to the finish, the one going the furthest distance within its lane wins. Any racer that crosses a lane marker shall be deemed to have finished the race at that point.

Winning racers will advance to the next round until all are eliminated except one which becomes the outright winner.



Ah well back to work!



Young Driver Development Course Conducted at Ringwood Park 14/8/10 Learn to be a competent driver

This course is designed for junior drivers from 12 to 18 years of age. The course will consist of tutorials on car control, safety and car preparation.

Driving instruction is on a one to one basis, with instructors approved by Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS). It is preferred that participants have some driving experience in sprint karts, motorkhanas, khanacross or RTA learners permit.

Pupils under 18 years of age will require a parent or guardian to sign entry forms to give permission.

A scrutineering (safety check) will be carried out on all vehicles 30 mins before the advertised start. Vehicles must be in a safe and roadworthy condition, though it does not have to be road registered. Single seat and dedicated competition vehicles (Buggys') are not permitted without the

approval of the Chief Instructor Safety apparel required is neck to ankle cotton-based clothing with long sleeves. A safety helmet in good condition and thin soled shoes are preferred.

Drivers of open topped sports cars must wear gloves and goggles or a helmet with a visor.

Cars should also be equipped with a fire extinguisher and seat belts in good condition.

Entry for junior members of MGCC Newcastle is free.

Entry for junior members of other car clubs is \$11.

Minimum requirement is a CAMS L1 (Come & try licence (\$25) which is a one day licence, but a CAMS L2SJ junior licence is available on the day for the lower cost of \$15 this licence is valid for 12 months.







Find a location for your Boot Release Button. I removed the blanking plug from next to the headlight height adjuster and fitted it there. As per photo. Next, run a figure 8 cable to the fuse box.


Remove the 2 mounting nuts. Turn the fuse box around slightly.

Caution - take care not to short the fuses out to earth.

Locate the wiring for the Boot Release Relay (shown in photo).


Join into the thin Black/with white trace wire with one wire from the switch figure 8 cable.

The other wire from the switch figure 8 cable goes to earth. I used the fuse box mounting bolt.




Refit fuse box with the 2 mounting nuts. Test Boot Release Button.

gency plan to be created if the same occurs again.


