





Young Driver Development Course Conducted at Ringwood Park 20/11/10 Learn to be a competent driver

This course is designed for junior drivers from 12 to 18 years of age. The course will consist of tutorials on car control, safety and car preparation.

Driving instruction is on a one to one basis, with instructors approved by Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS). It is preferred that participants have some driving experience in sprint karts, motorkhanas, khanacross or RTA learners permit.

Pupils under 18 years of age will require a parent or guardian to sign entry forms to give permission.

A scrutineering (safety check) will be carried out on all vehicles 30 mins before the advertised start. Vehicles must be in a safe and roadworthy condition, though it does not have to be road registered. Single seat and dedicated competition vehicles (Buggys') are not permitted without the

approval of the Chief Instructor Safety apparel required is neck to ankle cotton-based clothing with long sleeves. A safety helmet in good condition and thin soled shoes are preferred.

Drivers of open topped sports cars must wear gloves and goggles or a helmet with a visor.

Cars should also be equipped with a fire extinguisher and seat belts in good condition.

Entry for junior members of MGCC Newcastle is free.

Entry for junior members of other car clubs is \$11.

Minimum requirement is a CAMS L1 (Come & try licence (\$25) which is a one day licence, but a CAMS L2SJ junior licence is available on the day for the lower cost of \$15 this licence is valid for 12 months.



Of course the Post and 2HD/NewFM don't do this as a "Freebie". This is part of our negotiated promotional package.

2. Paid Publicity

This year, we decided to go with NBN again, 2HD/NewFM for the second year and the Post Group of Newspapers. Why not the obvious choice, The Herald you ask? Several reasons -

The former Motoring Editor, Brent Davison is not in that position anymore and although his name still appears, the column is done by others who will not publish anything about any of our events - or indeed any of our level sport and neither has the Sports Department acknowledged any phone calls or pre-written stories on State, Tri-Challenge, Mattara etc. for over 2 years unless part of a paid advertising package, where all news stories have to be supported by advertising.

Unfortunately, NBN had so much paid advertising this year, they cut us back from 48 ads to 28 - A fact of life! Last year's advertisement was re-jigged and some new footage added to do this years advertising.

2HD rang back after the Press Day debacle and said Richard would be available on Monday - or Tuesday, um...to go to the track, possibly! I said thanks, but no thanks. Phil couldn't afford another day off and neither could I on a "possibly" - again - smiling away through the phone.

This year though, we could get more air time on 2HD and NewFM, split over the two stations, and with 15 second slots - 35 with 2HD and 50 on NewFM. We still managed a couple of "Pre-event" interviews with several drivers in the week before, which all adds to the publicity.

The Post Group offered -

'Public Event' notices in Newcastle, Lake Macquarie and Hunter Post for five weeks leading up to the event.

Quarter page display (copies of our poster) for three weeks.

Double page spread published 13th October - supported by sponsors.

Follow-up pictorial published 20th October in the sporting news.

Some of our sponsors in the programme were again asked to support the Post feature, which although cheaper than the Herald is an added cost for some of our Club's sponsors and members - Many thanks.

As the ads start on Radio, TV and in the Press, other media start asking for interviews, the ABC (both FM & AM), Community Radio Stations etc. so arrangements are made with competitors who are locals and who have a chance of winning or at least placing well, to be interviewed.

Our good friends at NBN did a great job on the weekend with interviews at the track and a substantial news item on Saturday night plus recognition of Amy Mrcela's historic win on Monday night.

2HD, ABC and NewFM all wanted interviews with Amy in the following week and she spoke like a professional racing driver. Well done.

COMMITTEE POSITIONS

PRESIDENT

The leader, chairs committee meetings, and has the casting vote in case of a dead-lock decision. Delegates jobs to committee persons, encourages members at events, and always acts with the best interests of the Club and its members.

VICE PRESIDENT

Assists the President, stands in for him/her when the President is absent. Helps other committee members with any special projects.

SECRETARY

Takes the minutes, deals with the incoming and outgoing correspondence, circulates information to members, via the magazine, passes on information to the various panels. Answers inquiries about the club and its activities. Is in touch with CAMS a lot. Processes new members and keeps a database of club members up to date. Can appoint an assistant as Membership Registrar if necessary.

TREASURER

Handles the Club's accounts receives the money, deals with banking and investments. Is responsible for paying the accounts, keeping records, and making sure that the books are audited at the end of the financial year.

CLUB CAPTAIN

Organises the Club Championship Structure and maintains the Club member pointscore, as well as the calendar. Receives results and working bee records for the pointscore. Co-ordinates with panels to organises trophies after the events for distribution

EVENT CO-ORDINATOR

Is an important part of setting up the years calendar along with the Club Captain to construct the Club Championship pointscore. Helps other panel members to promote their events. Is responsible for

maintaining current list of calendar with event changes that often happen and supply to Editor a list of coming events for the current magazine. Ideally a NAMS delegate as well.

REGISTER CAPTAIN

An MG owner, someone who is likely to attend most of the Club Runs. Organises the monthly Register Runs, also the annual Concours. Keeps the register pointscore for MG owners, contacts MG members for promotional parades or displays.

REGISTER SECRETARY

Assists the Register Captain to plan and conduct MG events. Ensures inquires and correspondence specifically relating to MG's are considered and answered. May act as National Meeting Co-ordinator organising accommodation and travel arrangements. Looks after the Club's Vintage Plate Registration Scheme. Keeps abreast of MG information in Australia and overseas.

SOCIAL SECRETARY

Provides supper for Club Nights each month (does not have to cook) **can be purchased**. Organises other social outings as well as Christmas/Presentation Dinner and Natter Nights. Can form a social committee of helpers if necessary. Help with catering at events if required.

EDITOR

DOES NOT WRITE THE MAGAZINE, but receives articles written by others to edit and produce the magazine. Ensures the magazine is delivered to and from the printer. Organises the Magazine Assemblies and posting. Helps with the gathering of advertisers, artwork and invoices, along with Publicity Officer.

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY

Processes new members and keeps a database of club members information up to date. Ensures new members receive relevant information on joining.

PUBLICITY OFFICER

Inform members and the general public of our activities. Always striving to keep a high profile of the Club whenever possible. Extra promotion for large events such as State Hillclimb events at Ringwood, King Edward Park etc. Endevour to get Club information into newspapers, radios or magazines. May assist the Register Captain with displays and parades, and the Editor with advertisers for the magazine.

SPEED EVENT CO-ORDINATOR

Organises Tar Speed events such as Ring-wood Hillclimbs, Supersprints etc. This persons does not have to Direct all these events, but is responsible for making them happen and can assist Make sure event permits from CAMS are in place and suppregs are distributed to invited clubs. Make sure enough officials are organised and the venue is ready. Results to go to the Club Captain. Might keep mailing list of competitors.

AUTO TEST(MOTORKHANA) CO-ORDINATOR

Organises the Motorkhana/ Khanacross events for the year. Locate suitable venues. Once again does not have to organise all events, but responsible to organise officials, timekeepers, paperwork to CAMS etc. Send results to Club Captain.

RALLY PANEL

Organise Rallies/ Rallysprints/ Touring Road Events for the year. Can use other Directors, organise checkers, officials, liase with local authorities, Police, Foresty etc. paperwork to CAMS. Bring rally matters to committee for attention.

LAND PANEL

Is responsible for the maintenance of the Track and surrounding area at Ringwood. Organises any work to be done by other parties or organises and advertises working bees of club members for general maintenance of the Complex. Works closely with the Speed Event and Equipment maintenance Co-ordinators.

EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

Responsible for the maintenance of mechanical equipment at Ringwood Complex. DOES NOT HAVE TO FIX IT PERSONALLY, organises necessary work to be done by others, so that equipment is fully functionally. Makes recommendations to Committee re equipment needed.

COMMITTEE NO.1

This person has no direct responsibilities, helps other committee members with projects., may have previously been on Committee.

COMMITTEE NO.2

Must be first appointment to the Committee, assists other committee members. Is a good introduction to the running of the Club and its business and activities.

SHANNONS MATTARA HILLCLIMB WEEKEND

I guess Club Members at this time of the year wonder about our advertising effort to publicise the Mattara Hillclimb, what we do and with what media organizations.

The event promotion falls into two departments -

1. "Free" Publicity

Free publicity is mainly available from the regional news papers such as the Maitland Mercury (a Daily) and the Port Stephens Examiner (a weekly). These small newspapers are usually after upcoming news, but several prerequisites are essential to getting any news in their papers.

Both papers did before interviews with photos, and small follow up stories after, referring to the Mattara event.




