


I hope to talk son in law James into doing an article on our Midget refurbishment (hot up really).

### Running the Hillclimb Timing System

On the right hand side is the original timing system built in 1993 and on the left is one of the MG Car Club laptops running the Hillclimb program.




Most of the time (greater than 99%), the only actions are key in the car number and press the Enter key. On the computer screen the Drivers Name, Number of Run and Car is displayed (see below). Press the red Reset button on the original timer. This clears the previous run times and turns off the red light of the Staging Tree. As the car triggers each sensor, the computer displays the time in white and the calculated difference in yellow. The original timer also shows the time differences. When the car crosses the finish line, check that the time differences displayed on the computer and the original timer match (within 1 or 2 hundredths). If there are no penalties to be applied, press the "+" key on the number keypad. The times are saved.


