

Finally our new shed has been completed, and the job of transferring our equipment from the containers will now take place after levelling of the gravel in the open section. Also Paul Bower in his capacity as Maintenance Director will be setting up the maintenance section for those jobs that turn up. Permission has been given by the Board for the purchase of a water tank which will be placed at the end of the new shed. This will greatly increase our water storage capacity for reducing the dust on roads and motorkhana areas.

Track wise everything is well under way with most top soil being removed and a start on replacing it with the gravel from our quarry. Drainage pipes have been laid along with conduit to carry timing and power to various points around the track. Gravel removed from the quarry will greatly extend the usable area in the quarry with the old dam at the end being enlarged to control run off from the area.



I have also scanned Hillclimb Results for Ringwood from March 1992 and King Edward Park from 1995.

Some Changes and Explanations for the MGCCN 2013 Pointscores (and how they work) and the Vehicle Rules for 2013

In the first version of the MGCCN 2013 Pointscores (and how they work), for the Junior Champion Pointscore, the Open or Closed Sports Cars Group 2A and Group 2C were included in the Junior Production Category. This was a mistake, as these cars should be included in the Junior Specials Category. This has been corrected in Version 2 on the website now.

For the Vehicle Rules for 2013, some additional wording has been added to make the rules easier to understand.

4.9 Open or Closed Sports Car

4.9.1 General

Open or Closed 2 seater sports car, schedules A, B, C and Group 2A and Group 2C of the current CAMS Manual of Motorsport.

Drivers seat must be offset from the centreline of the vehicle.

For Group 2A engines are free.

For Group 2C forced induction is not allowed. Rotary engines are not permitted.

Wheels are free

Tyres are free.

Mudguards to provide covering to at least 1/3 of the circumference of the tyre, and must cover the full width of the tread.

The Group 2A and the Group 2C cars are combined into a common grouping with an Under 2 Litre and an Over 2 Litre capacity classes.

For those competitors who have only one set of numbers will now need to provide two sets due to the upgrade of the Ringwood circuit.

The next Ringwood hillclimb is scheduled for the 21st April. The pre-entry forms will be available online early April. Due to the continuing earthworks the pit area will only have a limited access for cars and trailers. Additional parking will be available within the motorkhana area. By then all competitors will see how challenging the new track will be, so all the best for future events.


