

troopers in the barracks upstairs. The officers covered a large area on horseback, keeping law and order and also coping with occasional visits by the bushrangers Thunderbolt and The Governor Brothers.

Other museum attractions include Dorathea MacKellar, the Orcihid Man of Paterson, a Les Darcy Display and the Tocal headless murder.

After a very educational hour of wandering through the museum and taking in the many stories and events of the times, we were preparing to leave, when we were given a special importune solo performance by one of the ladies sister who demonstrate for us how the pedal and bellows church organ sounded. It was a very special demonstration for us, as the organ had only just been received by the Society as a donation from the local church. Strange as it may have seemed to hear a church organ

being played inside a Court room, but somehow it just seemed to fit in, in an historic kind of way.
