Unfortunately we had to postpone the hillclimb at Ringwood on the 31st August to a date in October, it was just too risky to run fifty to seventy



To build the tyre bundles was one thing, but think about the number of tyres that were needed for the job They did not appear out of thin air, club members with a passion, went about collecting and sizing them for

assembly, then they were constructed and put in place. In my opinion, it was a mammoth undertaking.

We now have a venue equal to no other. The paddock area and pits are taking shape and with continued effort by DAD's army and any other volunteer that is prepared to step forward we will be able to present a venue more than suitable for the Australian Hill Climb Championship in November.

Thank you to all who have helped and supported this project.

I and others on the Board believe the club should be proud of this achievement and we should not rest on our laurels.

LAND PANEL REPORT

he open day for members was a great success with over 100 members attending and with food and drinks provided they enjoyed a walk or drive around the new extensions. It is to be hoped the enthusiasm will transfer into action and we will see more people at working bees as they are organized.

A lot of the final jobs are now being attended to and Alan's system of allocating jobs is working well.

The big news is that the paddock area's roads have been sealed which will assist in cutting down on dust and mud being carried onto the track by competing cars.

The debris fence at the end of the finish straight is nearing completion as is the new officials hut at turn 7. A safety barrier has been built around the sump in the middle of the paddock area. Ongoing work on ripple strips and edge protection

between turns 6 and 7 has been finished and ripple strip at 4 and 5 are being painted.

Paving of the covered area in front of the secretary's office is well under way and a area behind the office is being prepared for a new water tank which has been purchased, the reasoning behind this is that we had to buy in water as our toilet tanks had been depleted due to the large number of competitors and spectators.

Extra guardrail is to be erected at turn 9 to accommodate vehicles with tyres lower than 280mm; this is part of an upgrade of our track licence.

At time of writing it is raining which will top up our tanks ready for our coming events.

From here some of our group bid us good-bye and for the rest we headed off to book into our accommodation at the Potters Brewery.




