just one week away &


everyone concerned is flat out getting the last finishing touches ready. Just remember that all that work has to be undone so please turn up to the working bees after the event which is as important as setting up.

LAND PANEL REPORT

ell another month closer to the AHC, the event that the members have been working so hard for.

The new paddock area was used for the first time on the 21st September with the fine gravel on the tared roads being a problem, however this will eventually settle in and any excess being swept off before the next event.

On the work finished side the debris fence has been done, a second row of guardrail installed and painted at turn 8, the paving has been finished in front of the Secretary's office and has transformed the area into a very usable area, the new water tank to service the training hut has been delivered and a area is being prepared for it.

The training hut has been re wired with power and lights with a set of steps fitted and the area in front levelled. All the ripple strips and

concrete edges have been painted. The quarry has been enlarged and graded and will hold the overflow of trailers for the AHC.

Two larger windows have been fitted to the timing hut to give the timers a better view of the start line and the track. Guttering has been fitted to the large roof in front of the Secretary's hut to stop water running on the start area.

We have acquired some extra equipment for the shed, 2 benches, 60 tonne press, pedestal drill and a small lathe all of which should make life easier for the working members.

On the to do list the training shed needs to be painted.

Also a big thanks to those members who have been working on preparing KEP another big project our club is involved in.

The word tarmac has an interesting meaning. Macadam is a method for road construction developed by John Loudon McAdam in early 19th century. The problem of dust created by the advent of the automobile was solved in the early 20th century by spraying tar on to the surface of the macadam road to create the tarbound-macadam. Later a mixture of coal tar and ironworks slag, patented by Edgar Purnell Hooley as tarmac, was introduced.

Honorary Treasurer handles the Club's accounts, receives the money, deals with banking and investments. Is responsible for paying the accounts, keeping records and making sure that the books are audited at the end of the financial year.

Publicity Officer inform members and the general public of our activities. Always striving to keep a high profile of the Club whenever possible. Extra promotion for large events such as State Hillclimb events at Ringwood, King Edward Park, etc. Endeavour to get Club information into newspapers, radios or magazines. May assist the Register Captain with displays and parades, and the Editor with advertisers for the magazine.

Club Captain organises the Club Championship structure and maintains the Club member pointscore, assists with the calendar. Receives results and working bee records and attendance sheets for the pointscore. Co-ordinates with panels to organise trophies for distribution after the events.

Social Secretary provides supper for Clubnights each month, does not have to cook, can be purchased. Organise other social outings as well as Christmas/ Presentation Dinner and Natter Nights. Can form a social committee of helpers if necessary. Help with catering at events if required.

Magazine Editor does not write the magazine, but receives articles written by others to edit and produce the magazine. Ensures the magazine is delivered to and from the printer. Organises the Magazine Assemblies and posting. Handles gathering of advertisers, artwork and invoices.

MG Register Captain an MG owner, someone who is likely to attend most of the Club runs. Organises the monthly Register Runs, also the annual Concours. Keeps the register pointscore for MG owners, contacts MG members for promotional parades or displays.

MG Register Secretary assists the Register Captain to plan and conduct MG events. Ensures enquires and correspondence specifically relating to MGs are considered and answered. May act as National Meeting Co-ordinator organising

accommodation and travel arrangements. Looks after the Club's Historic Registration Scheme. Keeps abreast of MG information in Australia and overseas.

Event Co-Ordinator is an important part of setting up the year's calendar along with the Club Captain to construct the Club Championship pointscore. Helps other panel members to promote their events. Is responsible for keeping the calendar current with event changes that often happen, and supply to Editor a list of coming events for the current magazine. Ideally a NAMS delegate as well.

Chairman of Rally Panel organise Rallies/ Rallysprints/ Touring Road Events for the year. Can use other Directors, organise checkers, officials, liaise with local authorities, Police, Forestry etc., paperwork to CAMS. Bring rally matters to committee for attention.

Chairman of Speed Event Panel organises Tar Speed events such as Ringwood Hillclimbs, Supersprints etc. This persons does not have to direct all these events, but is responsible for making them happen and can assist. Make sure event permits from CAMS are in place and supp regs are distributed to invited clubs. Make sure enough officials are organised and the venue is ready. Results to go to the Club Captain. Might keep mailing list of competitors.

Chairman of Autotest Panel organises the Motorkhana/ Khanacross events for the year. Locate suitable venues. Once again does not have to organise all events, but responsible to organise officials, timekeepers, paperwork to CAMS etc. Send results to Club Captain.

Chairman of Equipment Maintenance Panel responsible for the maintenance of mechanical equipment at Ringwood Complex. Does not have to fix it personally, organises necessary work to be done by others, so that equipment is fully functionally. Makes recommendations to Committee re equipment needed.

Membership Secretary processes new members and keeps a database of club members up to date. Ensures new members receive relevant information on joining.

Chairman Land Panel is responsible for the maintenance of the Track and surrounding area at Ringwood. Organises any work to be done by other parties or organises and advertises working bees of club members for general maintenance of the Complex. Works closely with the Speed Event and Equipment Maintenance Co-ordinators.

Member No.1 This person has no direct responsibilities, helps other committee members with projects, and may have previously been on Committee.

Member No.2 Must be first appointment to the Committee, assists other committee members. Is a good introduction to the running of the Club and its business and activities.



POWERHOUSE MUSEUM'S AUTO OBSESSION

ost people that know me would say I'm obsessed with cars, so when I saw an advertisement for the *Auto Obsession* display at Sydney's Powerhouse Museum and I happened to be going to Sydney in a few weeks time, I just knew I had to check it out.

The *Auto Obsession* display features over 25 cars and bikes owned by the museum. Some of these cars are restored whilst others are preserved in their original condition. Also as part of the display are other motoring artefacts as well as a collection of 600 Matchbox cars (I never counted them).

Unfortunately for MG fans there aren't any MGs as part of the collection but



some of the interesting cars they had on display were a 1959 Goggomobil Dart, a 1965 XP Falcon (cut away to show the inner workings and how it was built), a 1965 Rolls Royce Phantom limousine (as used by the NSW Governor complete with police radio so the driver could radio ahead to have traffic lights changed and gold crowns rather than number plates), a

1913 Sheffield Simplex luxury tourer (one of only three surviving made by the Sheffield Simplex Motor Works Ltd, England) and a Nota Fang type IV. The oldest car in the collection was a 1905 Cadillac Model F (originally owned by Sir Robert Lucas-Tooth of the famous Sydney brewing family, whilst the newest car was a 1970

Chrysler Valiant Regal VF with a "Fireball" 318 V8.

For bike fans, of particular interest was an Australian made 1948 125cc 2-stroke Waratah. After I was finished drooling over the Auto Obsession display I had a wander around the other exhibits and I was pleasantly sur-

prised to find that there were other automotive gems hiding in there as well. These included the Bugatti Type 37 driven by Bill Thompson to win the 1932 Australian Grand Prix and even the Big Red Car from the Wiggles (part of the Wiggles exhibition currently on display).

The Auto Obsession display runs until October 26 and is a great way to spend an after-

noon and it is well worth checking out if you are in the vicinity.


