

WHO KNEW (the rule)

Lodging your entry for a competition event is a routine task for regular competitors, however many don't get it done correctly. This generally means an increase in the work required by the Event Secretary, something that as volunteers these key officials don't require.

One mistake that happens is that the entry form isn't posted to the correct address. The Supplementary Regulations will state where and how entries should be lodged. For Hillclimbs our preferred method is via CAMS Event Entry, with the Entry fee being paid via the Credit card to CAMS who then forward the payments to the Club's bank account, or by Direct Deposit to the Club's Bank account. The "Supplementary Regulations' is again where all this detail is listed. NCR 76 (ii) states: - "For an entry to be valid the entry fee must be received by the organiser prior to the closing date of entries." Should a full field be reached by close of entries and to your payment not having been received, you are likely to be in a situation where you won't get to run, even if you lodged your entry form or electronic version early, but without the payment. It is also important that you post hard copy entry forms to the address stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations as any other address used may see the entry being overlooked completely or received well after it should have been.

Emailing of entries is a valid method, if offered by the Organiser, again this will appear in the Supplementary Regulations if it is. Sending an entry to just any email address associated with the Club will not necessarily arrive at the Event Secretary's email in time. (This happened with 3 entry forms for the recent Tri-Challenge event, the entries were apparently sent to membership@mgcarclub.com.au and were not passed on.) The key message is "READ THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS"

Entry via CAMS Event Entry is very quick and easy once you get set up, but it is important to visit your "Member Profile" regularly to ensure your details are up to date. Information such as your address, phone number, emergency contact details, Club Membership details, car details etc are all up to date, as the information required by event organisers is all sourced from this data. Getting the details of your car correct is also important as it will reduce the risk of you being put into a class that you don't wish to be in. The Class for our events should always show the prefix "MGCCN". The best way to make this clear is to have your car set up individually for each of the event types you run in. Some people do this with the same car listed 3 different ways to cover Club, State and CSCA classes, and it works well for them.

Here is the top menu layer of the website.

About Us Club Runs Motorsport Club Info Ringwood Hire Contact

The menu items across the top of the screen have drop down menus. Just below the top menu, the sliding pictures show adverts for the next few events. Clicking on the picture will take you to the event page where the Supplementary Regulations and Entry Form are stored and can be downloaded.

On a number of the menus, the Calendar selection displays different event items depending on whether the event is categorised as Motorsport, Club Runs (non motorsport). The Motorsport events are additionally filtered by event discipline of Hillclimb, Motorkhana, Khanacross, Supersprint, Circuit Racing, Young Driver Training and MG National Meetings.

The results of any event are found on the individual event page and the Motorsport / Results Archive menu.
