RINGWOOD DRIVEWAY UPGRADE

You may have heard that your board has approved the funding of a new driveway into Ringwood Park.

This project commenced in August 2019, a steering committee was then created, with a lot of procrastination during this year, to verify the benefits of the expenditure, it was then agreed to appoint the services of a civil engineer, to design a new road, including enclosed drainage, being the main benefit for this project, also to widen the intersection to the spectator area, increase the size of the Khanacross within the quarry, the design called for a new road being 645 m in length 5 m wide plus a 1.2m wide enclosed drainage, commencing from Italia Road and keying into the asphalt road finalising, near the spectator area.

Tenders were then produced and issued to seven Earth Moving Contractors, resulting in two complying tenders, and one non complying tender.

Following considerable interviews with engineers and contractors, recommendations were placed to your board on the 20th October for the approval and acceptance of the tender submitted by D C B Civil Contracting.

With the completed earth works, Colas Australia will then spray seal, the total area being of approximately 3200 m2.

The contractor commenced construction on the 2nd November, and subject to weather should finish on week commencing 7th December this year.

During the construction period, access will only be provided to club members to attend Ringwood events, during Saturday or Sunday, access during the week unfortunately will not be permitted, including those members of Dads Army.

My gratitude is extended to those club members, who assisted with the commencement of this project, the completed driveway will greatly enhance the Ringwood facility.


