



SPEED REPORT

Hi All.

Well, everyone is talking about the fantastic finish to Tar Series Hillclimb Round 2 (TS2) on Saturday 24 April 2021 at Ringwood Park Motorsport Complex. With the newly approved MGCCN Outright Hillclimb Championship established for this round, there was plenty of interest and competition for points at the sharp end of the field.

The last car in the final run of the day was the black 1979 Chev Corvette driven by Andrew Fraser. As he approached the starting line, he was in 2nd place outright just a quarter of a second behind Adam Single in his blue Subaru WRX. In his previous run, Andew had spun out while trying to get the fastest time of the day.
