PRESIDENTS REPORT

Well what a busy month it's been. Hillclimbs, Supersprints and Khanacrosses at night, Motorkhanas, Young Driver Development, a Mid-Week run, Track hire events, Private practice and even a Working Bee. It's been non-stop and anyone that says there is nothing to do has rocks in his or her head.

With many of the same faces being seen at these events anything you can do to help support the club by volunteering some time can help. As they say, "Many hands make light work". This is even more important as we come into the second half of the year, with many of our bigger events such as the State Hillclimb and Mattara still to come. If you wish to help out as an official we can sign you up on the day, or simply come and lend a hand with any of the numerous other tasks available.

Many of our competitive events have been getting full fields and we are having to close entries early. Most of our events are run on a first come, first served basis, and this has unfortunately meant that some of our regulars that have waited till the last minute to put in an entry have either missed out or been placed on a reserve list. If you are planning to enter an event please try and get your entries in early.

Club members have been busy behind the scenes as well. Planning is well under way for next years MG National Meet. Staged at various locations around Lake Macquarie, it will make for a very picturesque event with many of the events such as the Concours and Motorkhana be held right next to the lake itself. If you own an MG please register an expression of interest on the website to be kept in the loop with further info on whats coming up.

Personally I have been trying to compete at some events, particularly if I'm not required as an official. The last such event happened to be the Tri-Series Hillclimb round at Tamworth, and along with it is the story of how I won 'half' a trophy.

Many of the plentiful Newcastle contingent such as myself made their way up on Saturday morning for the afternoon practice session. The day was fairly uneventful, but some of us decided to camp rather then book a room in a motel. Thankfully we had decent sleeping bags as the temperature dropped into the negatives, leaving a layer of frost to welcome us as we awoke in the morning.

The Type 1, U2L class consisted of just two competitors, Anthony Rogers in a Mazda and Myself in the Kia. On our first run out I went quicker then I had in practice, however Anthony was quicker again. Much to my dismay he admitted that his car hadn't been running 100%, likely due to fuel surge. With him topping up the tank before the next run I knew I had my work cut out for me. Sure enough, he went out and set a time of 45.4320, and whilst I improved again, I was well over half a second slower.

On the previous two runs I noticed the stability control was cutting in on turn 2, slowing my exit speed. With only 1.2L under the bonnet I needed to carry every KPH I can through the corners. For the third run it was turned off which was good for another improvement, and with Anthony having a tyre issue he was unable to go any quicker. I was now within 0.2s.

On the final run the track temps were cooling, and as many of us know that usually results in less grip and slower times. This was the case for Anthony, so his time from the second run still stood. I however was still learning the track, and putting together I what I had already figured out I decided it was time to 'Send It'. With caution thrown to the wind I went out and gave it everything I could. No traction control, no stability control, and was using every inch of the kerbing I could. Three laps later I pulled into the paddock and checked my time. 45.4320. An identical time to Anthony. As we both were called up and awarded a trophy for the equal first position I pondered what could have been; If only I hadn't had that extra hotdog from the canteen.


