Tri Challenge Round 3 at Raleigh International Raceway 13-14th August 2022

Hosted by Kempsey Sporting Car Club, the event saw sixteen of our members venture north for the event, which received 64 entries, but with withdrawals for a range of reasons there ended up being 58 starters. Thirty-eight of those practiced on Saturday afternoon including our crew.

The track layout is quite tight, as one would expect from what is primarily a Go-Kart Track,. Unfortunately the owner has not kept up the maintenance required, so in some areas it was breaking up, which required a set of chicanes to be added, making it even tighter.

Practice got underway later than advertised, due to work required to get the track cleaned and set up, The morning weather wasn't good but thankfully things were OK by the time cars were running and drivers finding their way around what was for some, a new track. There were no incidents, and the weather was looking good for the Sunday's official runs.

After a lengthy briefing, drivers did a convoy tour of the course so that they could be updated on where the chicanes and other issues were around the track. Competition got underway about ½ hour late, and given the number of cars running, it became apparent that only three runs would be possible, so everyone was trying to get a good time set from the 1st run just in case things didn't work as well later in the day.

Darren Read was always going to be the man to beat and as expected took a significant lead into Run 2 and was able to lower his time by 2.17 second, which left him in the lead by about 3 seconds. He didn't contest run 3.

Second went to Jackson Haloran from TSCC, then Dave Morrow KSCC and a very good result from Adam Single (MGCCN) taking out 4th ahead of some Type 5 entries from Grafton.

The largest class was the SV AWD over 3 litre class, and it was to be where the toughest competition was seen with 17 entries. Two young guns fresh from Go Karting set the pace with WAC member Samuel Hadley taking a class win with a 47.363 second run to best one of our newest members Riley Brunner on 47.366, (how close was that!) next was Peter Akers on 47.679, Kenneth Atkins on 47.732, Troy Morley 48.240. Jim Hull in his GR Yaris won his class with a 47.983

Our members outright placings, were Adam Single 4th, Riley Brunner 8th, Peter Akers 9th, Kenneth Atkins 10th, Jim Hull 11th, Troy Morley 12th, Terry Lanesbury 19th. Colin Brookes 20th, Kevin Akers 23rd, Dean Mears 25th, Rick Yates 27th, Amanda Single 30th and First Lady, Connor Morley, 34th, Andrew Chandler 43rd, James Graham 45th, Simon Nicholson 48th. There were several class winners within the list.

With the final round of the Tri Challenge coming up at Ringwood on 1st and 2nd of October at our "NAPA Autoparts Mattara Hillclimb", the inter-club challenge points are quite close with MGCCN on 185 then KSCC 183 and TSCC on 122.

The outright Drivers Pointscore has Darren Read in the clear lead with 34 points followed by Kenneth Atkins and Peter Akers both on 25 and Jim Hull next on 15. Peter Akers has a two-point lead in the SV over 3 litre class over Kenneth but depending on the outcome of the State Championship Tin Top points after Gunnedah, Peter will have to decide if he is to contest the Tri Challenge award or the State "Tin Top" Award, unfortunately the Canberra Round of the State Championship clashes with our traditional Mattara Long weekend date.


