As the end of 2022 draws closer, the number of events still to run becomes smaller and smaller. As we enter November, we have completed all of our Motorkhana and Khanacross events for the year, and only have a single round of the tar speed series left to complete. Many of the pointscores in the various championships now have a clear leader, whilst others look to be going right down to the wire.

The last Motorkhana of 2022 saw a great turnout, and some hardfought battles amongst the competitors. With a variety of tests on offer, some seemed to fall into the preference of 2wd cars, whilst others were better suited to 4wd. In the end car choice wasn't a major deciding factor, as yours truly threw a spanner in the works with a couple of 'choose your own route' style of tests. These are great fun, and its rather interesting to see what ideas and methods the drivers come up with in order to try and achieve the fastest time. As the drivers take turns in competing, it starts to become clearer where time can be saved, and where it can be lost.

Credit must go to Michael Dern, who seemed to excel at these tests. In both cases nearly the entire field ended up copying what would later be referred to as "The Dern Method" as it proved to be the fastest route. The eventual winner of the day was Lewis Penfold in the Audi A4, followed by Neil Ferry in the Mirage, and Chris Burrows in a Laser.

October also saw some of our members making the trek up to Queensland to compete in the Australian Hillclimb Championship. Whilst rain did put a dampener on proceedings, including the cancellation of the final days racing, it appears to have still been a worthwhile trip. Graham Orr took out the Limited Mods Road Car – up to 1600cc class, whilst Tim Blake won the 2A Sports Cars – 4WD class.

The other good news to come from Queensland was the announcement that MG Car Club Newcastle has been given the opportunity to host the Australian Hillclimb Championship for 2023. This is a massive opportunity for our club, and one we look forward to. This obviously means we have a lot of work to undertake over the next 12 months to ensure Ringwood is in the best condition possible, and the event runs as smoothly as possible. This means we are on the hunt for some new faces to join us in 2023 to help out wherever possible. At our AGM we will be looking for members to join the committee to assist in the running of the club and its events. We will also be looking at the formation of a sub-committee to oversee the planning, 'organisation and promotion of the Australia Hillclimb Championship, and I know Dad's Army would be grateful for any help they receive to help get Ringwood into tip top condition.

As always, I look forward to seeing you at one of our events. There isn't many left for the year, so lets do our best to make them count.

- Current Financial Membership Cards should be produced in order to obtain Voting papers.
- Voting papers will not be issued after the current Board positions are declared vacant
- Nominations should be completed and posted or handed to the Secretary at least 7 days prior to the commencement of the meeting
- Associate Members are permitted to cast proxy votes for a Full Member who is absent; only if the Proxy form is completed and posted, emailed to, or handed to the Secretary prior to the commencement of the meeting.

### **BOARD POSITIONS - SUMMARY OF THE ROLES**

#### The Board positions are covered by the Club's Constitution, which should be read in conjunction with the below.

#### The Constitution is available via the Club's website.

#### President - the leader.

Chairs Board meetings and has the casting vote in case of a deadlock decision. Delegates jobs to Board persons, encourages members at events, and always acts with the best interests of the Club and its members. Supports Board members in the performance of their roles. Is the Public Officer of the Club.

#### Vice -President - assists the President.

Stands in for him/her when the President is absent. Helps other committee members with any special projects.

#### Honorary Secretary -

Takes the minutes of Board Meetings.

Deals with the incoming and outgoing correspondence.

Circulates information to members, via the magazine and passes on information to the various panels.

Answers enquiries about the club and its activities. Is the Club's primary contact with Motorsport Australia.

### Honorary Treasurer - Handles the Club's financial accounts.

Receives the money.

Deals with banking and investments.

Is responsible for paying the accounts.

Keeps the financial records.

Prepares the Annual Financial Reports and has them audited for presentation to the AGM and subsequent lodgement with the Department of Fair Trading by the Public Officer.

Publicity Officer - informs members and the general public of our activities.

Always striving to keep a high profile of the Club whenever possible.

Organises promotion for large events such as State Hillclimb events at Ringwood Park, etc.

Endeavour to get Club information into newspapers, radios, or magazines. May assist the Register Captain with displays and parades, and the Editor with advertisers for the magazine.

#### Club Captain - Keeps the Point Scores.

Receives event results, working bee records and attendance sheets for the point score.

Keeps the point score for the Club and Event Championships and maintains the Club Member point score, assists with preparation of the calendar. Co-ordinates with the various panels to organise trophies for distribution after the

events.

#### Social Secretary - Organises social outings.

Arranges for the provision of supper for Club Nights each month, (does not have to cook, supper items can be purchased.)

Organise other social outings as well as Christmas/Presentation Dinner and Natter Nights. Ideally forms a social committee of helpers.

#### Magazine Editor - Compiles the magazine.

Receives articles written by others to edit and produce the magazine. Ensures the magazine is delivered to and from the printer. Organises the Magazine Assemblies and posting. Co-ordinates the gathering of advertisers, artwork, and invoicing.

**<u>Register Captain</u>** – Co-ordinates activities for the MG owning members and others.

Someone who is likely to attend most of the Club runs.

Organises "Register" or "Club" Runs.

Plans for the annual Concours.

Keeps the register point score for MG owners.

Contacts MG members for promotional parades or displays.

Maintains a close liaison with the Register Secretary to promote the interests of MG owners.

Works with the Event Co-ordinator to ensure activities are included in the calendar.

#### **Register Secretary -** assists the Register Captain.

To plan and conduct MG events.

Ensures enquires and correspondence specifically relating to MGs are considered and answered.

Looks after the Club's Historic Registration Scheme.

Keeps abreast of MG information in Australia and overseas.

Maintains a close liaison with the Register Captain to promote the interests of MG owners.

May act as National Meeting Co-ordinator organising accommodation and travel arrangements for MGCC(N) members.

#### **Event Co-Ordinator** – Co-ordinates the formulation of the Club Calendar.

Works with all Panel Co-ordinators and the Club Captain to set up the year's calendar.

Construct the list of Club Championship point score events.

Helps other panel members to promote their events.

Is responsible for keeping the calendar current with event changes that often happen.

Supply to the Editor a list of coming events for inclusion in the magazine. Provides the Webmaster with updates as they occur.

#### Chairman of Rally Panel – Co-ordinates and Promotes Rally type events.

Keeps abreast of Rallies, Rallysprints, Touring Road Events and Touring Assemblies that are scheduled for the year.

Works with Event Co-ordinator to schedule "Rally" events in the calendar.

Ensures that any MGCC(N) promoted and scheduled events are organised in a timely manner, does not have to set, or run them himself.

Brings "rally" matters to the Board for attention as required.

Provides information and reports to the Editor on "Rally" events



### **BOARD POSITIONS - SUMMARY OF THE ROLES**

**<u>Chairman of Speed Event Panel</u>** – Co-ordinates a panel of like-minded members to organise Speed events.

These include Ringwood Hillclimbs, Supersprints etc.

This person does not have to direct the events but is responsible for making them happen and can assist.

Ensures event permits from CAMS are in place and supp regs are available and distributed in a timely manner.

Make sure enough officials are organised and that the venue is ready.

Results to go to the Club Captain.

Works with the Event Co-ordinator and Publicity officer to maintain accuracy of the calendar and promote the events.

Chairman of Autotest Panel - Co-ordinates a panel of like-minded members to organise Motorkhana/Khanacross events for the year.

Locate suitable venues.

Does not have to organise the events, but ensures events are organised in a timely manner and arrange for officials, timekeepers, paperwork to Motorsport Australia etc. Sends results to Club Captain.

Works with the Event Co-ordinator and Publicity officer to maintain accuracy of the calendar and promote the events.

Membership Secretary – Keeps the register of members.

Receives new membership applications for presentation to the Board for approval. Processes membership renewals.

Liaises with the Treasurer on the recording of membership payments.

Prints and distributes Membership Cards.

Keeps the database of club members up to date.

Ensures new members receive relevant information on joining.

Provides a list of members who are to receive a hard copy of the Magazine.

Ensures new members receive relevant information on joining.

<u>Chairman Land Panel</u>. Co-ordinates a panel of like-minded members and is responsible for the maintenance of the infrastructure at Ringwood.

Organises any work to be done by other parties.

Organises and advertises working bees of club members for general maintenance of the Complex.

Works closely with the Event and Equipment Maintenance Co-ordinators.

Makes recommendations to the Board on improvements and works at Ringwood.

<u>Chairman of Equipment Maintenance Panel</u> - Co-ordinates the work required to maintain of mechanical equipment at our Ringwood Complex.

Does not have to fix it personally and may organise necessary work to be done by others, so that equipment is fully functional.

Makes recommendations to Board regarding equipment.

Member No.1 - This person has no direct responsibilities, helps other Board members

Member No.1 - This person has no uncertresponsionated, helps out at board members, with projects, and may have previously been on the Board.
 Member No.2 - Must be first appointment to the Board, assists other Board members. This is a good introduction to the running of the Club, its business, and activities.
