A	*	First Name	As this will be used on the name tag, it needs to be your preferred first name eg Wes instead of Wesley, Chris instead of Christine. Please check your spelling.
B	*	Surname	As this will be used for the name tag, it needs to be your preferred surname. Please check your spelling.
C	*	Date of birth	Needed for the correct functioning of the registration software. Mandatory question but answers will not be stored in National Meeting results data base. Used to determine eligibility for the Jean Kimber Cook Trophy (awarded for the best performance by a Junior in the Motorkhana).
D	*	Gender	Used to determine eligibility for the Joan Richmond trophy (awarded for the best performance by a female).

1	*	Which MG Car Club will you be associated with?	Proof of membership must be provided by Competition and Kimber Run participants at registration.
2	*	Are you registering as a Social participant or entering Competition events?	<p>You will be asked this question twice.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Social registration allows you to attend all Social Events (including meals) but you cannot enter a car in the Concours. You can participate in the Rocker Cover Racing, Social Run and the Kimber Run. • Competition – Concours Only Competition - Concours Only registration allows you to enter one car in the Concours and attend all Social Events (including meals, the Kimber Run and the Social Run). • Competition - Full Competition - Full registration allows you to participate in all Social Events as well as the Concours, Motorkhana, Super Sprint or Observation Run.

5	*	Are you willing to be a Concours judge? If yes, tick yes AND other then enter the class or model of car you wish to judge in the text box.	Ideally, we need 3 judges per class. With 33 classes this mans we need 99 judges. Every possible attempt will be made to have at least one experienced judge per class to assist the inexperienced judges.
6		What is your Motor Sport Australia license number? (Not required for Social or Competition – Concours Only Participants)	<p>You do <u>NOT</u> need a Motor Sport license to enter the Concours, the Kimber Run and the Social Run. Enter TBC if you do not have a license but need one to compete in your desired events. Proof of a current license must be provided by participants in Motorkhana, Super Sprint and Observation Run at registration.</p>

7		Car 1: Which MG model will you be entering in competition and/or social events? (A second car may be nominated later in question 14)	Only one person can enter a car in the Concours. Car details must be provided by all competitors if the car is double or family entered.
8		Car 1: Which Class will you be entering? [to be confirmed at scrutineering]	If unsure, please make an educated guess.
9		Car 1: What is the registration number OR engine number of the car?	It is not necessary to provide both
10		Car 1: What is the car colour?	Keep this answer as short as possible.
11		Car 1: What is the year of manufacture of the car and what modifications have been made to the car?	This answer will be used to check that the car has been entered in the correct class. Separate your answers with a semi-colon. Answer Nil for no modifications
12		Car 1: What is your preferred competition number?	First person to ask for a number gets it. The registrar will contact you if your desired number is unavailable. If you have no preference do not provide an answer. You will then be assigned a competition number by the registrar.
13		Car 1: If you are a Super Sprint competitor, please provide details about Dorians.	Dorian timers are used to provide lap times at the Super Sprint. If you have a Dorian timer tick "I have my own Dorian" AND "Other" AND provide the Dorian number. A fee of \$20 will be charged for the hire of a Dorian.
14		Car 2: Which MG model will you be entering in competition and/or social events?	A car entered as a second car CANNOT be driven in Motorkhana and Super Sprint by more than one person.
15		Car 2: Which Class will you be entering? [to be confirmed at scrutineering]	If unsure, please make an educated guess.
16		Car 2: What is the registration number OR engine number of the car?	It is not necessary to provide both
17		Car 2: What is the car colour?	Keep this answer as short as possible.
18		Car 2: What is the year of manufacture of the car and what modifications have been made to the car?	This answer will be used to check that the car has been entered in the correct class. Separate your answers with a semi-colon. Answer Nil for no modifications
19		Car 2: What is your preferred competition number?	First person to ask for a number gets it. You will be assigned a competition number if you have no preference.
20		Car 2: If you are a Super Sprint competitor, please provide details about Dorians.	If entering 2 cars, you must use 2 different Dorians. Dorian timers are used to provide lap times at the Super Sprint. If you have a Dorian timer tick "I have my own Dorian" AND "Other" AND provide the Dorian number. A fee of \$20 will be charged for the hire of a 2 nd Dorian. (\$40 for the hire of 2 Dorians)


