

SOCIAL SECRETARY

It's Club Night again on Friday 12th April and I am hoping for another big turn-out from club members. Our guest speaker is Shaun from Hunter Heart Safe with a hands-on (literally!) session that will take the scare out of being a bystander when someone – perhaps even someone you know – experiences sudden cardiac arrest. My mother would have dearly loved me to be a doctor, but I turned out to be quite a chicken when it came to accidents and emergencies. The Hunter Heart Safe website shows what a terrific job the volunteers do to educate all manner of community organisations.

The Club Night session will be brief (around 30 mins) and teaches cardiac arrest recognition, hands only CPR and AED usage. The aim is to keep sessions brief, accessible, simple and empowering. Hands only CPR has been shown to be as effective at saving lives in cardiac arrest as traditional CPR with rescue breathing. A bystander is more likely to initiate chest compressions if they don't feel obliged to perform mouth-to-mouth breathing. Hands only CPR is an easier skill to teach, learn and maintain.

Supper, as usual, will be sumptuous, and the jackpot is up to a whopping \$600.00. Could you be the winner?

Looking ahead to May, Hal Moloney is booked for Club Night on the 10th for a night of motoring nostalgia entitled "Do You Remember?" and for those who enjoy Natter Nights, the very first one since covid will be at Ken and Louise's Kotara South home on Saturday 18th May. TRI SERIES ROUND 1 2024

The weather forecast was not great for the first round of the 2024 tri series hosted by the Kempsey Sporting Car Club on 16-17/03/24 at their Mt Cooperbung track.

Saturday practice went ahead with roughly only a dozen of the competitors taking advantage of the mostly dry track. In the end, it turned out the better day trying weather wise to get that PB.

Sunday race day started with a wet track. Everybody (excluding Peter Akers) took it easy on the first run to feel out the track's level of grip.

Peter Akers set a blistering pace in his WRX and was 1st outright by a couple of seconds after run 1. The wet track suited his 4WD grip as he put the open wheelers on notice. Peter would hold out Luca Cox right through until to the 4th run where the drying track favoured Luca in the Hyper Racing X5 on slicks. Peter eventually took out 1st in Special vehicle over 3lt class and 2nd outright with a 28.549s run behind Luca.

The next fastest from MGCCN was Mitch Craig in his EP3 Civic Type R. Mitch's times tumbled consistently and he got down to 31.162s on the slightly damp track on his last run and took out 1st in Type 2 Under 2lt class and 9th outright.

Rick Yates in his Mini Cooper battled in class with a Torana, with the class lead swapping back and forth a number of times. Rick ended the day on top with a 32.608s run to take out 1st in Type 3 Over 2lt class and 12th outright.

Rob Dawson brought along his latest acquisition, a Porsche Boster S, but struggled with rear wheel grip from the Porsche all day. Rob finished with a 33.143s run to take 1st in Marque Sports over 3lt class and 16th outright.

Nathan Apps also in his new acquisition, a FN2 Civic Type R, dropped a second on each run to finish only 0.071 of a second

behind Rob, with Nathan's best time of 33.214s earning 1st in Type 1 under 2lt class and 17th outright.

Michael Taylor in his Morris Minor battled it out against another Morris Minor dropping almost 9 seconds from his first to last run, finishing the day with a best of 42.982s taking 2nd in Type 4 under 2lt class and 31st outright.

With all three clubs represented in the top three, the series couldn't look better. (maybe a few more MGCCN competitors though)

Round 2 of the Tri series is at Ringwood on 26th May, so expect to see a lot more MGCCN members competing here.

ALL BRITISH DAY 27TH APRIL 2024

The All British Day is open to all British Made or Badged Cars, Trucks and Motorcycles.

You don't have to be a member of a club to come along and show your pride and joy.

There is **No Charge** for this event but it would be nice if you can purchase some raffle tickets and Regalia on the day.

1. Entry is from the Wharf Road entry point only and please respect the traffic situation and regulations regarding making a Right Hand Turn across any oncoming traffic.

Please do not block the traffic flow from the East.

The JDCHR suggests and recommends that vehicles enter from the East i.e. from the Nobby's end of Wharf Road."

Go to the end of Wharf Road and negotiate the round about so that you travel back along Wharf road in a westerly direction so the park is on your left side.

2. Entry to the park will be from 0800 and once you have entered the park form 2 lines and follow the directions of the Marshalls.

3. Do not block the flow of traffic or pedestrians.

There will be other Marshalls located in the park area to direct you to Club Allocated positions and also to ensure the safety of the general public. Please respect the directions of these Marshalls.

4. If for some reason you need to leave the park earlier than the completion of the day please contact a Marshall to allow a safe exit from the park. Entry Gate will close about 0930 to ensure the safety of the general public. Each entrant will receive a bag that contains some advertising and the parking permit for the day. This PERMIT issued by NCC Must be filled in and displayed on your windscreen.

There will also be a Voting Slip that you can vote for the best car on the park. If you wish to vote this must be filed in and returned to the JDCHR Regalia Table by 1100 so votes can be counted.

The Presentation for the best car on the day being First, Second & Third will be at 1230.

2NURFM will be broadcasting on the day from 0900 to 1200 so tune your radios to 103.7 and enjoy the interviews and music.

Please ring me if you're attending so we can allocate you a space on the park.
