The manner in which the results will be determined and prizes awarded	Prizes and/or Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Outright. Other prizes and/or trophies may be awarded at the Organiser’s discretion.
OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS	<p>Maximum of 40 entries. Maximum of 3 entrants per vehicle.</p> <p>Entry Fees – ADULTS = \$40; JUNIOR (other Motorsport Australia affiliated club) = \$20; MGCCN JUNIOR = \$Free</p> <p>This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.</p> <p>This Event will have Instructors in vehicles. Junior entrants under the age of 18 may have an instructor. Junior entrants under the age of 14 MUST have an instructor. An experienced competing Instructor may carry a Junior Entrant Passenger for the purpose of observed training. A request must be lodged with the Event Organisers who will determine the suitability of the passenger or the experience of the driver prior to approval. Passengers must sign in as per the MSPRA policy, <u>produce their Motorsport Australia Licence to the Secretary of the Event or Clerk of the Course</u>, and at no time are they allowed to drive the vehicle unless they have entered the Event and have the appropriate licensing. Only one passenger is allowed in any vehicle at any time during competition. Each Passenger must wear apparel compliant with Technical Appendix – Schedule D and must use a seat belt compliant with Technical Appendix – Schedule I.</p>

At no time can the passenger assist with control of the vehicle (eg “third” hand assisting with handbrake. Penalty = Disqualification from results)

Test Penalties will be applied as per the Motorkhana Standing Regulations. In addition to this, any entrant deemed to be exceeding track limits to gain an advantage will be penalised 5 seconds for each instance.

Competing vehicles must remain within the paddock area for the duration of the Event, except when lining up for the designated dirt test sections. If a competing vehicle needs to use the venue access road leave the venue during the Event, the driver must first notify to Clerk of the Course or Secretary of the Event.

Vehicles must remain parked in paddock bays when not competing. It is not permitted to drive around the paddock at any time before, during or after the Event other than to transit to scrutineering / refuelling bay and the designated test sections.

Failure to comply will result in penalties, including a 120 second time penalty, and possible disqualification from the Event and suspension from future participation at Ringwood Motorsport Park for repeat offenders.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.
- The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation.

Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
