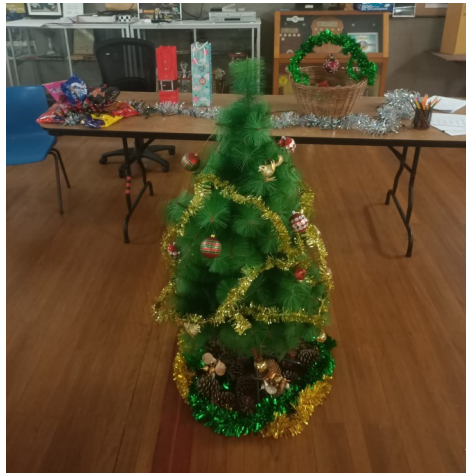
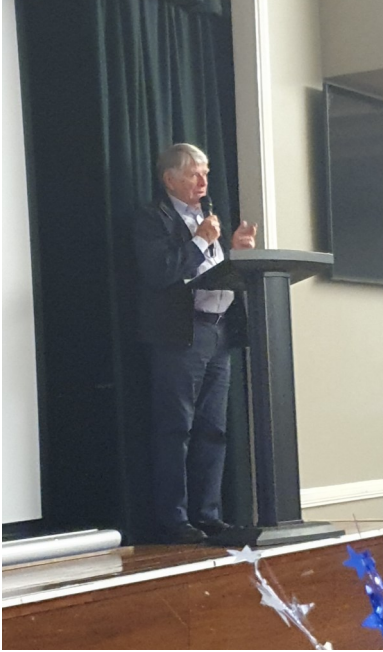
It was a great opportunity to catch up with members and other members of the public to talk about past, current and future activities.

NSW STATE HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Round 6 of the NSW State Hillclimb Championships was held at Tamworth's Oakburn Park on 19-20/07/2025. Practice on Saturday saw 30 of the competitors take to the track to learn or refresh their memory of the venue prior to race day. The weather was perfect, the track was clear, but a little slippery. No incidents to report. 37 entrants competed on Sunday. With an earlier start than the previous days practice sessions, track and tyre temps were considerably down early on.

The low temps and grip allowed competitors to gradually tune their setup and commitment level to improve times as it warmed up. As usual, the open wheel classes went toe-to-toe all day until Miles Hoare improved by over 2 seconds on his last run to take 1st in class and 1st outright from Dave Morrow in 2nd outright and Brian Cox getting the better of Luca Cox to take out 3rd and 4th outright respectively. The AWD tin top competitors pushed their various classes aside on Sunday and had a great battle on every run with Simon Quayle finishing the day with fastest tin top and AWD bragging rights. Along with Simon, Les Maloney, David Hussey and Greg Keam intensely pushed each other on every run.

There was also some good competition across the 2WD cards swapping places on the leader board to add to the excitement of each and everyone's individual achievements. Les Maloney and Jason Perkins both took detours into the grass during the day with some cosmetic damage to both cars, but neither sustained enough damage to take them out of the event and after safety checks, both continued on to improve their times.

As has been the case with every round of this year's state hillclimb championship, competitor numbers were down. Of the 37 entries, only 26 State registered competitors and 11 non championship competitors. With 14 different classes contested across 26 state entries at this event, I'm a little nervous of the future of the championship. I see the massive amount of time that volunteers put into the championship management as well as each club that hosts each round.

Like MGCCN, I'm sure every club is hunting for ideas to bolster numbers at events. With the last round of the 2025 NSW hillclimb championship held on 9-10 Aug at our very own Ringwood Park, come on MGCCN members, lets show the championship what a great club we have and how engaged and competitive we are with motorsport.

Get an entry in, even if you're not part of the championship as it's also run as a club event where you can often embarrass the state competitors with how good you are on home soil. If you're not into competing, still come along as a spectator or volunteer as an official and watch some of NSW and a few interstage drivers compete to finalise state championship placings.

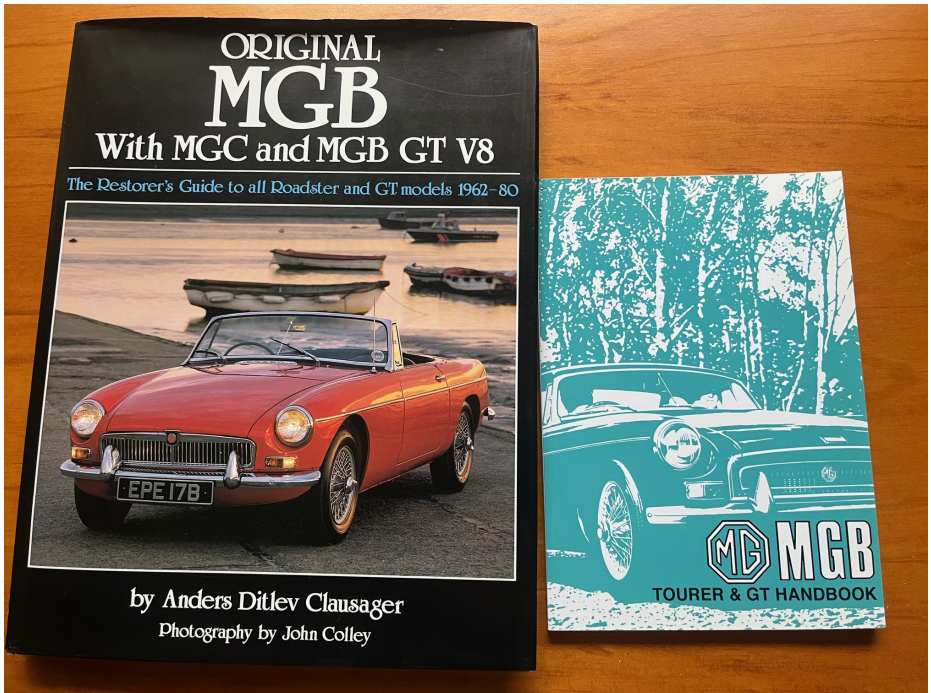
