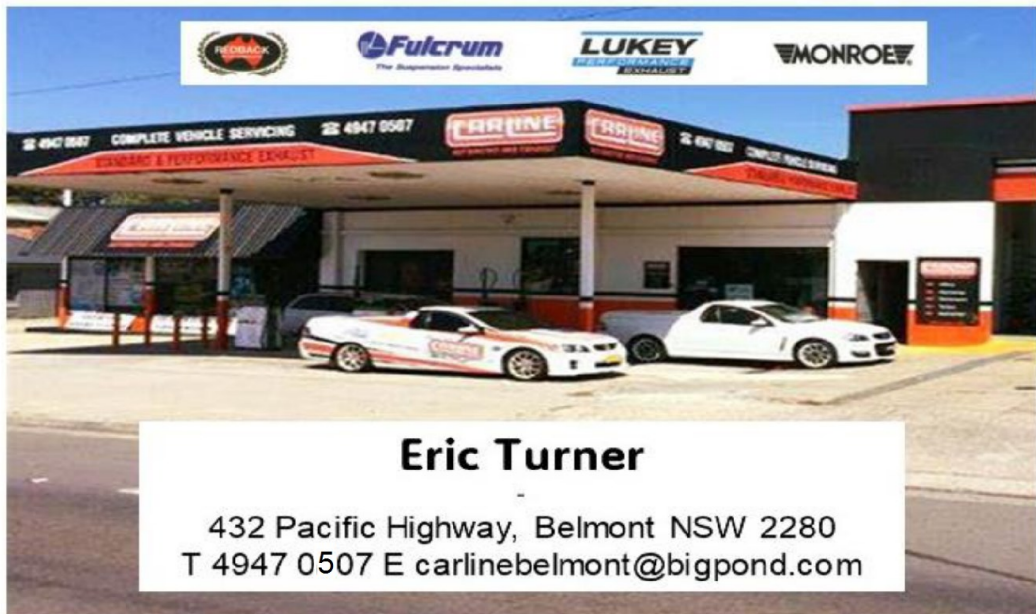

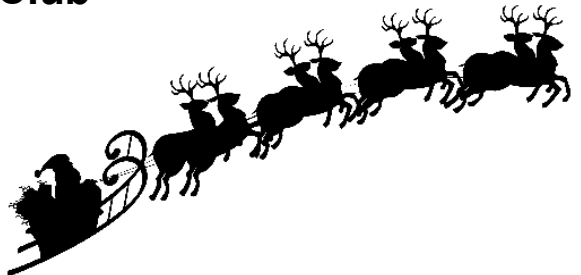

REGISTER SECRETARY

We have had 7 new historic vehicles added to our register since the publication of the October magazine, two of which are relisting's under new ownership arrangements.

1971 Toyota Corolla
1992 Nissan Pulsar
1983 Holden Gemini
1995 Nissan Skyline
1964 AC Cobra
1969 VW Beetle
1944 Willys Jeep

There were 17 registration renewals processed in September and a further 23 to date 24th October.

There are approximately 261 vehicles listed currently on our Historic Register.

At our Tri Challenge Hill Climb I had some competition from another historic vehicle entered in my class. It was a 1959 Turner Alexander Sports Car based on Ford 109E 1.3L motor, transmission and axle and Triumph Herald double wishbone front suspension. They were a low volume UK manufactured competition orientated car with a good reputation for handling and performance in its era. It was well driven and beat my best time by around 3 seconds.



It was great to see another, this time, American classic car competing a beautifully presented Corvette Stingray, one second quicker than me in my Triumph TR7.



Spotted in the spectator parking area at the same event was a Ford Escort Panel Van in very original looking condition.



I had intentions of going up to our Ringwood Circuit to take a look at the Triumph Owners Club event. Unfortunately, I strained my back a few days before and climbing into the TR7 and driving 40 minutes in traffic operating a heavy clutch did not appeal. Instead I took the Mazda, easier to get into, for a five minute drive to Lambton Park to check out the Hunter Region MG Club Annual Concours event. There were some nice cars on display as one would expect. There were two vehicles that I had not seen before that took my interest; an historic UK manufactured Marlin Roadster and a brand-new Chinese manufactured MG Cyberster. Gone are the compact MG Sports Car day's the all-electric Cyberster was enormous, see how it dwarfs the MGB alongside.

The Marlin was more typically a British Sports Car, built in 1983 from a 1971 Morris Marina doner car. It features the Marina torsion bar front suspension retrofitted with telescopic dampers and has a substitute MGB motor with a single carburettor.

ANNUAL CONCOURS & CLUB PLATE DAY

The weather was beautiful for this year's Concours and Club Plate display day at Ringwood Park complex on Sunday 26th October. The Concours and Club Plate display day were combined in the hope this might encourage more cars to enter the Concours. Of course, there was also the prospect that combining might distract from the focus of either event. Setting classes for the Concours depends on the cars entered on the day, this time I grouped cars into like years to try to avoid older cars being judged against much younger cars.

We had a similar amount of Concours entrants to previous years – and the standard and variety of cars was high. I was impressed to see several members who do not attend events on a regular basis as well as some new members. I hope to see them at some Club runs in the year to come.

One thing for owners to remember is that it's important to take as many personal items out of the car as possible to allow the judges to inspect all aspects of the car. I've always been supportive of holding a Concours even if general consensus is that we are not really a "Concours Club", to allow those cars that may not be used for racing or other competition to be presented and admired. (Our MGs are guaranteed of a good detailing at least twice a year – once at MG National Meeting time and once more for the Club Concours.) It's also time for conversation and memory sharing. Of course, if you are chasing points for the Club Championship, it's a great way to bolster your tally.

It was pleasing to see 2 MGTCs and the more modern MGs were well represented. We missed our MGB and MGA members – hopefully we'll see them next year. While Ringwood is a distance away from the Clubrooms for the Concours, the road into the area is sealed which reduces the dust although I'm a bigger fan of the Clubrooms (as it's 30 minutes closer to home for me and has ready access to air-conditioning!)

- Any other business as submitted in accordance with the Club's Rules.
- Members are reminded that Special Business needs to be submitted to the Board before the meeting.

Rules: Members are reminded of the following: -

- Only full Members are allowed to vote
- Both Full and Associate Members can accept a nomination for a position on the Board of Directors
- Both Full and Associate Members can nominate any Club Member for a position on the Board of Directors
- Associate Members will be granted Full Membership if elected to the Board of Directors
- Members must be financial to 28th February 2026 to be able to vote
- Current Financial Membership Cards should be produced in order to obtain Voting papers.
- Voting papers will not be issued after the current Board positions are declared vacant
- Nominations should be completed and posted or handed to the Secretary at least 7 days prior to the commencement of the meeting
- Associate Members are permitted to cast proxy votes for a Full Member who is absent; only if the Proxy form is completed and posted, emailed to, or handed to the Secretary prior to the commencement of the meeting.
- All Proxy forms must be signed by the member appointing the proxy and must comply with our constitution.

BOARD POSITIONS - SUMMARY OF THE ROLES

The Board positions are covered by the Club's Constitution, which should be read in conjunction with the below.

The Constitution is available via the Club's website.

President - the leader.

Chairs Board meetings and has the casting vote in case of a deadlock decision.
Delegates jobs to Board persons, encourages members at events, and always acts with the best interests of the Club and its members.
Supports Board members in the performance of their roles.
Is the Public Officer of the Club.

Vice—President - assists the President.

Stands in for him/her when the President is absent.
Helps other committee members with any special projects.

Honorary Secretary -

Takes the minutes of Board Meetings.
Deals with the incoming and outgoing correspondence.
Circulates information to members, via the magazine and passes on information to the various panels.
Answers enquiries about the club and its activities. Is the Club's primary contact with Motorsport Australia.

Honorary Treasurer - Handles the Club's financial accounts.

Receives the money.
Deals with banking and investments.
Is responsible for paying the accounts.
Keeps the financial records.
Prepares the Annual Financial Reports and has them audited for presentation to the AGM and subsequent lodgement with the Department of Fair Trading by the Public Officer.

Publicity Officer - informs members and the general public of our activities.

Always striving to keep a high profile of the Club whenever possible.
Organises promotion for large events such as State Hillclimb events at Ringwood Park, etc.
Endeavour to get Club information into newspapers, radios, or magazines.
May assist the Register Captain with displays and parades, and the Editor with advertisers for the magazine.

Club Captain – Keeps the Point Scores.

Receives event results, working bee records and attendance sheets for the point score.
Keeps the point score for the Club and Event Championships and maintains the Club Member point score, assists with preparation of the calendar.
Co-ordinates with the various panels to organise trophies for distribution after the events.

BOARD POSITIONS - SUMMARY OF THE ROLES

Social Secretary - Organises social outings.

Arranges for the provision of supper for Club Nights each month, (does not have to cook, supper items can be purchased.)

Organise other social outings as well as Christmas/Presentation Dinner and Natter Nights. Ideally forms a social committee of helpers.

Magazine Editor - Compiles the magazine.

Receives articles written by others to edit and produce the magazine.

Ensures the magazine is delivered to and from the printer.

Organises the Magazine Assemblies and posting.

Co-ordinates the gathering of advertisers, artwork, and invoicing.

Register Captain – Co-ordinates activities for the MG owning members and others.

Someone who is likely to attend most of the Club runs.

Organises “Register” or “Club” Runs.

Plans for the annual Concours.

Keeps the register point score for MG owners.

Contacts MG members for promotional parades or displays.

Maintains a close liaison with the Register Secretary to promote the interests of MG owners.

Works with the Event Co-ordinator to ensure activities are included in the calendar.

Register Secretary - assists the Register Captain.

To plan and conduct MG events.

Ensures enquires and correspondence specifically relating to MGs are considered and answered.

Looks after the Club’s Historic Registration Scheme.

Keeps abreast of MG information in Australia and overseas.

Maintains a close liaison with the Register Captain to promote the interests of MG owners.

May act as National Meeting Co-ordinator organising accommodation and travel arrangements for MGCC(N) members.

Event Co-Ordinator – Co-ordinates the formulation of the Club Calendar.

Works with all Panel Co-ordinators and the Club Captain to set up the year’s calendar.

Construct the list of Club Championship point score events.

Helps other panel members to promote their events.

Is responsible for keeping the calendar current with event changes that often happen.

Supply to the Editor a list of coming events for inclusion in the magazine.

Provides the Webmaster with updates as they occur.

Chairman of Rally Panel – Co-ordinates and Promotes Rally type events.

Keeps abreast of Rallies, Rallysprints, Touring Road Events and Touring Assemblies that are scheduled for the year.

Works with Event Co-ordinator to schedule “Rally” events in the calendar.

Ensures that any MGCC(N) promoted and scheduled events are organised in a timely manner, does not have to set, or run them himself.

Brings “rally” matters to the Board for attention as required.

Provides information and reports to the Editor on “Rally” events

Chairman of Speed Event Panel – Co-ordinates a panel of like-minded members to organise Speed events.

These include Ringwood Hillclimbs, Supersprints etc.

This person does not have to direct the events but is responsible for making them happen and can assist.

Ensures event permits from CAMS are in place and supp regs are available and distributed in a timely manner.

Make sure enough officials are organised and that the venue is ready.
