- Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual. In addition to the apparel requirements as specified in Schedule D, the MGCCN requires Drivers and Passengers are to wear long sleeved, non-flammable clothing as per Schedule D specifications.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Cars must be adequately muffled.
- Competitors must produce a valid and current:
 - Motorsport Australia Competition
 - Licence Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club
 - Log Book (if issued)

The manner in which the results will be determined and prizes awarded	Prizes and/or Trophies will be awarded for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd Outright. Other prizes and/or trophies may be awarded at the organiser's discretion.
OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS	<p>Maximum of 40 entries. Maximum of 3 entrants per vehicle.</p> <p>Entry Fees – ADULTS = \$55. JUNIOR (other Motorsport Australia affiliated club) = \$28. MGCCN JUNIOR = \$Free</p> <p>Entrants can choose to compete in Tar Only or Dirt & Tar sections of the Event.</p> <p>THE CHANGING OF TYRES BETWEEN TESTS TO SUIT THE CHANGE OF SURFACES IS NOT PERMITTED (exception: a damaged tyre or wheel can be changed in the interest of safety and continuing competition).</p> <p>Entrants' competition numbers will be issued on the day and must be displayed on the Left and Right sides of the vehicle. (We will <u>not</u> be using MGCCN Reserved Hillclimb numbers for this event)</p> <p>Multiple entrant vehicles are required to cover numbers that are not driver completing the test.</p> <p>This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.</p> <p>This Event will have Instructors in vehicles. Junior entrants under the age of 18 may have a passenger as an instructor. Junior entrants under the age of 14 MUST have an instructor. No other passengers will be permitted.</p>

	<p>Instructors shall have a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Coach licence.</p> <p>Penalties will be applied as per the Khanacross Standing Regulations. In addition to this, any entrant deemed to be exceeding track limits to gain an advantage will be penalised 5 seconds for each instance.</p> <p>Competing vehicles must remain within the paddock area for the duration of the Event, except when lining up for the designated dirt test sections. If a competing vehicle needs to use the venue access road leave the venue during the event, the driver must first notify to Clerk of the Course or Secretary of the Event.</p> <p>Vehicles must remain parked in paddock bays when not competing. It is not permitted to drive around the paddock at any time before, during or after the Event other than to transit to scrutineering / refuelling bay and the designated test sections.</p> <p>Failure to comply will result in penalties, including a 120 second time penalty, and possible disqualification from the event and suspension from future participation at Ringwood Motorsport Park for repeat offenders.</p> <p>Payment of entry fees can be done by Credit Card through the Motorsport Australia online portal or by Direct Deposit to the following account: • BSB 646 000 Account 000000905 – MG Car Club (Newcastle) Inc.</p>

- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.

INTEGRITY

Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
