1. THE EVENT will be a **Club Hill Climb** held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Hill Climb Standing Regulations, this Event will be conducted under and in accordance with these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletins that may be issued. The Event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia's Occupational Health and Safety Policy, Integrity Policies, Legal Policies, Risk Management Policies, Safety 1st Framework and any other relevant Policy.

2. THE EVENT will be held at: Mount Cooperabung Hill Climb from the 14th – 15th of March 2026.

3. THE EVENT will be conducted under Motorsport Australia Permit No: **226/1503/05** has been issued and will be displayed at the Event.

10. MINIMUM LICENCES:

Current Motorsport Australia Speed Licence, vehicle log book (if issued), and current club membership card are compulsory and must be produced at the Event.

11. EVENT FORMAT: SCRUTINY will be held at: Pits prior to the event Sunday from 8.00 am.

a) All vehicles must comply with Technical Appendix Schedule A & B of the Motorsport Australia as specified in the Motorsport Australia Manual, including a fire extinguisher (Technical Appendix Schedule H); blue triangle (for battery) and a secondary method for fastening the bonnet.

b) Maximum Noise Limit: 95 **dba** at: 30 **metres**. Any vehicle found to exceed the maximum noise emission limit will be suspended from the Event until the Chief Scrutineer / Clerk of the Course is satisfied that action has been taken to bring it within the limit.

c) Competition numbers are to be positioned on the side of the vehicle

d) Drivers and vehicles must be presented in a clean and tidy manner.

e) Note: The Event will not be delayed due to late arrivals.

f) It is the Drivers' responsibility to ensure their vehicles are Scrutineered before the scheduled starting time of the Event.

g) Drivers must attend Scrutineering personally so that their driving apparel can be checked.

h) Drivers Briefing will be held at: 9.15 **a.m.** It is compulsory for **ALL drivers to attend**. Scrutiny will cease whilst the Drivers' briefing is in progress. Note: A driver "sign-on" sheet must be signed by all Drivers to prove briefing attendance, failure to sign on may result in penalties being applied by the Stewards of the Event.

i) The EVENT commences at: 9.30 **a.m.** and finishes at: 4.00 **p.m.**

12. VEHICLE CATEGORIES AND CLASSES:

TYPE 1 - Road registered cars as per Tri Series Vehicle Rules.

TYPE 2 - Road registered modified as per Tri Series Vehicle Rules.

TYPE 3 - Modified cars incl. 3J Club Cars as per the current Motorsport Australia Manual & Tri Series Vehicle Rules.

TYPE 4 - 2D Sports Sedans as per the current Motorsport Australia Manual & Tri Series Vehicle Rules.

TYPE 5 - any vehicle which cannot be classed as type 1, 2, 3, 4, SV or MS.

SV - Road registered kit cars, Limited Compliance, Production Turbo 4W/D and/or 4W/S. under/over 3000cc.

MARQUE SPORTS - under 2000cc, 2001 - 3000ccs, over 3001ccs.

Open or Closed 2 seater sports car, Group 2A.

Open or Closed 2 seater sports car, Group 2C.

Clubman Road Tyres

Clubman Race Tyres

The Organisers may reclassify an entry if they believe it is not eligible for the class in which it has been entered.

13. FUEL: All Competitors are permitted to use any fuel as defined in Technical Appendix Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual. **Vehicles running on alcohol** shall have signage indicating the use as is prescribed in Schedule G.

14. DRIVER SAFETY:

Drivers must wear apparel that complies with Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual, including:

a) A helmet that complies with AS1698 or better (as per Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual) and carries marking to that effect or is otherwise specifically approved by Motorsport Australia.

b) Non-flammable clothing, including cover from throat to wrists to ankles (apparel of **nylon or similar** material is forbidden). Flame retardant overalls, or better, are highly recommended

c) Suitable **flame retardant footwear** (thongs, open sandals, high-heeled shoes and **nylon joggers** are forbidden), and

d) In open cars, goggles or a visor with a lens material other than glass (to AS1609) are mandatory as are leather or Nomex gloves which entirely cover the hands.

15. REPLACEMENT VEHICLES: At the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course, a driver whose vehicle has broken down may use a replacement vehicle. The replacement vehicle must have been Scrutineered and preferably be in the same category/type and class as the original vehicle. Where the original vehicle has recorded a time and the Scrutineered replacement is not in the same category/type and class as the original vehicle, the replacement vehicle will not be eligible for prizes and/or trophies.

16. TIMING EQUIPMENT will be: with an accuracy of 1000th of a second.

17. RERUNS: Reruns will be permitted at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course. A restart will only be permitted if the rear wheels have not crossed the start line, if a red flag is displayed on the hill or a miss time occurs. If required, it cannot be run before 5 other vehicles have had their runs.

18. AWARDS will be presented at the pits at 4.00 p.m. and will consist of Trophies 1st 2nd 3rd outright and first in class.

19. AUTHORITY OF OFFICIALS: Any driver not following a reasonable instruction by an official during the Event may be excluded from the Event at the discretion of the Stewards of the Event.

20. MEDICAL FACILITIES: SES first Aid officer, Vehicle and phone.

21. CRASH RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING FACILITIES: are at the start corners 1, 2, and pits a tow vehicle will be positioned at near the Start

22. INSURANCE: Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia.

23. PROTESTS: Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

24. CANCELLATION: The Organisers reserve the right to postpone or cancel the Event in accordance with the NCR.

25. INTEGRITY:

Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia. Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

26. REFRESHMENT FACILITIES available: at the pits BBQ and soft drinks for lunch.

27. ADDITIONS AND/OR ALTERATIONS: Any additions and/or alterations to these Supplementary Regulations will be notified to all Drivers in **Further Regulations** or during the **Drivers' Briefing**.

 - the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a **disease**;
 - the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other **condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs**:
 - that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
 - that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community,

- howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motorsport Activities;
- to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified Motorsport Australia and the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motorsport Activities at my own risk.

I understand that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of Motorsport Australia and the Entities as the supplier of the Motorsport Activities and Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents Motorsport Australia and the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded, however the liability of Motorsport Australia and the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a Motorsport Australia insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- Motorsport Australia has arranged for limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motorsport Activities. I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by Motorsport Australia may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motorsport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account Motorsport Australia's insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.

Where Motorsport Activities are held in the following jurisdictions, I acknowledge that I have also read and accept the following warnings:

Under the Australian Government Consumer Law (which is part of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Commonwealth)), several guarantees are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. - a. a sporting activity; or
- b. a similar leisure time pursuit or any other activity that:

- i. involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and
- ii. is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.

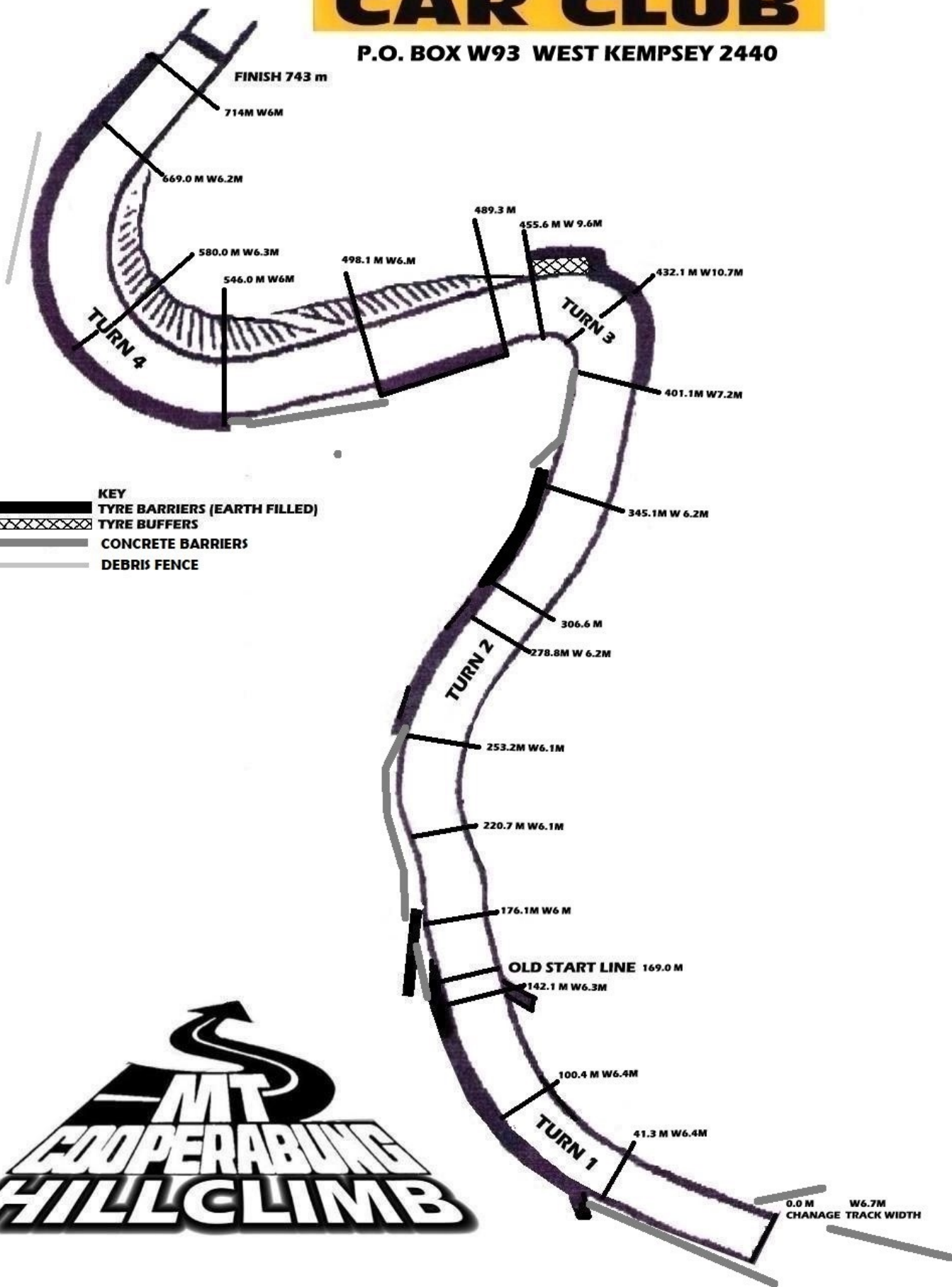

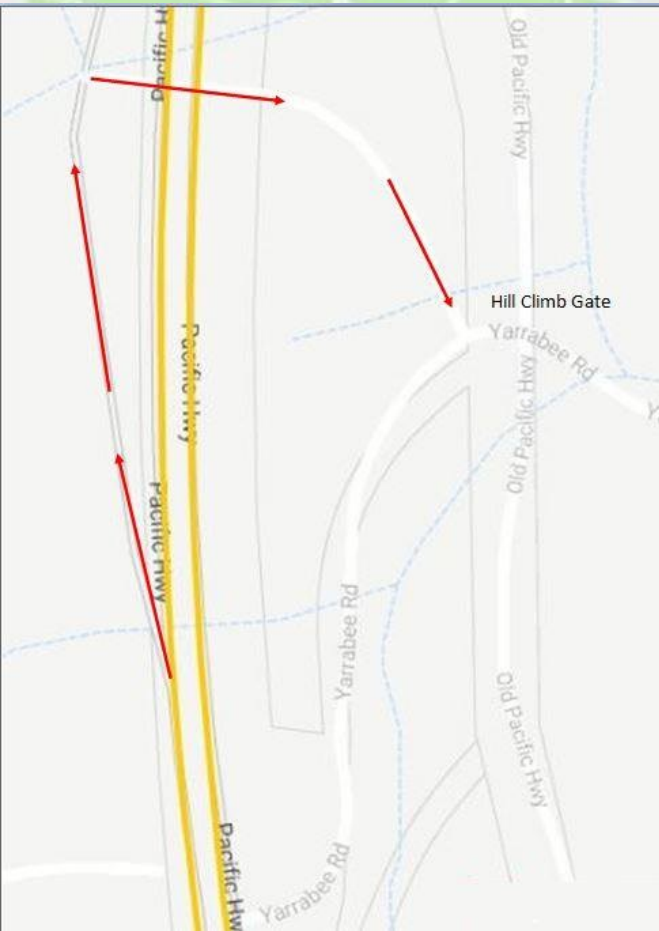
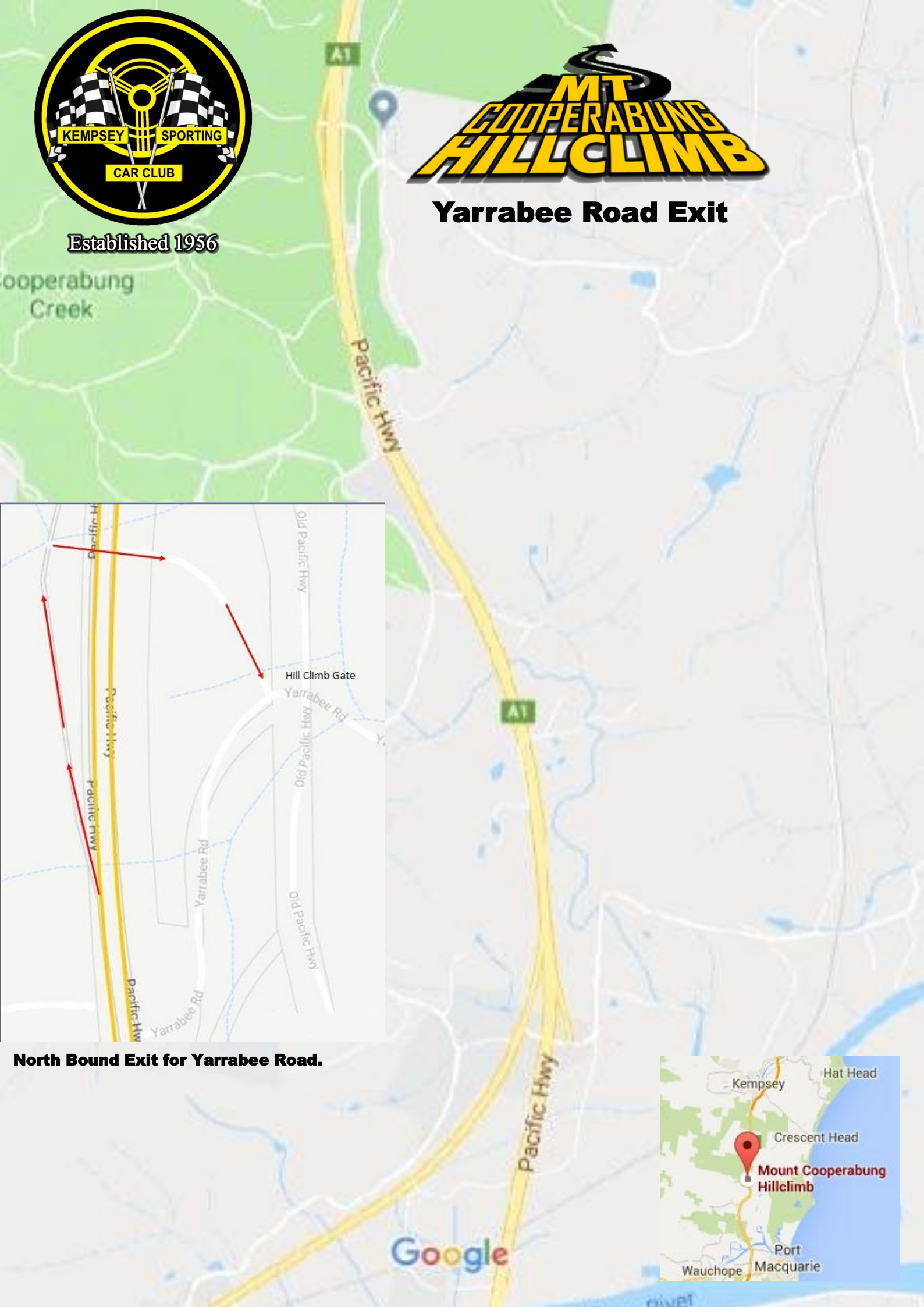
