The MG Car Club of Tasmania extends a warm invitation to members to attend the 2027 MG National Meeting to be conducted in and around Launceston, Tasmania.

For those who may not be familiar with Tasmania, Launceston is about an hour's travel time from Devonport if coming by ship or for those flying in, about twenty minutes from the airport. We look forward to welcoming you and sharing all that this wonderful region has to offer.

Our base will be the Tailrace Function Centre (TFC) at Riverside, approximately 10 minutes drive from the Launceston CBD. This will be the centre for all the social events. The program for the meeting is as follows:

Concours will take place at Longford, site of the original Longford racing circuit, which is approximately 30 minutes drive from the TFC. The Speed events are scheduled for Buckby Motors Symmons Plains Raceway, home of the V8 Super cars; approximately 30 minutes drive from the TFC. Meanwhile, the Discovery Run and Kimber Run will wind along country roads that highlight the region's agricultural heritage.
