- All vehicles must comply with Technical Appendix Schedule A and Group 4K of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual. In addition to the apparel requirements as specified in Schedule D, the MGCCN requires Drivers and Passengers are to wear long sleeved, non-flammable clothing as per Schedule D specifications.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Cars must be adequately muffled.
- Competitors must produce a valid and current:
 - Motorsport Australia Competition
 - Licence Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club
 - Log Book (if issued)

The manner in which the results will be determined and prizes awarded	Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, inclusive of penalties. All times on each test will count. Timing shall be to 0.01 Second. Trophies for 1st, 2nd, 3rd outright. 1st in each class and category where 3 or more entrants are present.
OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS	The Event will be Round 6 of the NSW Khanacross Championship. The Event will be held on Dirt & Tar surfaces. The Event will consist of a minimum of 4 Khanacross tests. The Event Timekeepers will act as the Judges of Fact. The Judges of Fact will be identified at the drivers briefing. The Facts to be judged include Start/Finish Procedure, valid course attempts and application of penalties. The Running Order will be Provided at the drivers briefing. Due to the compact nature of the Ringwood Park tracks, maps of the tests will be provided in lieu of a vehicle-based reconnaissance.

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy & restricted to Junior entrants under the age of 18 who may have an adult passenger as an instructor.

No other passengers will be permitted.

Instructors shall have a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Coach licence.

The changing of tyres and/or suspension components between tests to suit the change of surfaces is not permitted (exception: a damaged tyre or wheel can be changed with a like tyre/wheel in the interest of safety and continuing competition).

Entrants' competition numbers will be issued on the day and must be displayed on the Left and Right sides of the vehicle.

- Multiple entrant vehicles are required to cover numbers that are not driver completing the test.

Penalties will be applied as per the Khanacross Standing Regulations.

In addition to this, any entrant deemed to be exceeding track limits to gain an advantage will be penalised 5 seconds for each instance.

Competing vehicles must remain within the paddock area for the duration of the Event, except when lining up for the designated dirt test sections.

If a competing vehicle needs to use the venue access road leave the venue during the event, the driver must first notify to Clerk of the Course or Secretary of the Event.

- Vehicles must remain parked in paddock bays when not competing. It is not permitted to drive around the paddock at any time before, during or after the Event other than to transit to scrutineering / refuelling bay and the designated test sections.
- Failure to comply will result in penalties, not limited to forfeiting the run following the incident, or disqualification from the event forfeiting of all times from the day.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.
- The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or cancel the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

INTEGRITY

Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
